Norman® reserves the right to discontinue this annual scholarship program in future years.</p>
ELIGIBILITY	<p>Applicants must be immediate family members of Budget Blinds franchise owners. Definitions of immediate family members for this purpose are children, grandchildren, nephews, nieces, and siblings of franchise owners. Franchisees must be in good standing with both Norman® and Budget Blinds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Application open to high school seniors anticipating completion of high school diploma in the 2019-2020 academic year• Minimum overall 3.0 GPA at the end of their junior year• U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident• Have not previously won any scholarships from Norman®• Planning to enter a Bachelor's Degree program at an accredited higher education institution in the fall directly after graduating from high school
AWARDS	One scholarship worth \$5,000 and up two scholarships worth \$2,500 each.
APPLICATION DEADLINE	September 30, 2019 for Fall 2020 admission
SELECTION & PROCESS	Applicants must submit the on-line application, which includes a personal essay and 2 reference letters, on or before September 30, 2019 to be eligible for the following year's fall scholarship. Norman® Window Fashions, at its discretion, will select the recipients for this scholarship based on the strength of applications by December 31, 2019.
PAYMENT	The scholarships will be paid by Norman® directly to the educational institutions in lump sum if permissible, or in set tuition frequency, up to a maximum of \$5,000 per recipient.
